



We look forward to your attendance at the Mayflower German Shorthaired Pointer Club's Hunt Test. If you are planning to enter, please complete the premium early enough to ensure an entry space and return to the Event Secretary by the closing date listed on the premium along with a check for the entry fees.

**GALLERIES:** Spectators will be allowed to walk the braces as long as accompanied by a Hunt Test Marshal. Everyone in the field must have a blaze orange vest and hat. Spectators must follow the instructions of the Marshal and may not enter the bird field at any time.

**HANDLERS:** BLAZE ORANGE HATS AND VESTS MUST be worn by handlers in all events

**DIRECTIONS;** From te North or South-take Route 95 to Route 3 South (Cape Cod). Follow Route 3 to the Sagamore Bridge Rotary and take your first right onto the Scenic Highway. Do not go over the Sagamore Bridge. Follow the signs to Route 28 Falmouth/Buzzards Bay/Bourne Bridge. Cross over the Bourne Bridge and follow Route 28 to the Route 151 Exit-Mashpee. Take a right at the bottom of the ramp and follow Route 151 approximately 1 1/2 miles to the entrance of Francis A. Crane Wildlife Management Area on the left. You will pass a cinema just before the entrance and a ball field is on the right after you turn onto the road which leads to the hunting area.

**WATER:** Please bring plenty of water for your dog(s) it is NOT available on the grounds.

**FOOD:** A fantastic selection of breakfast and lunch items will be available at reasonable prices.
